

*Commonly asked questions:*

**1) I'm having problems registering online, what do I do?**

Try following the HELP directions on the WEVA registration page. If still having problems contact the registrar, Mark Bowers ([mlbowers@aol.com](mailto:mlbowers@aol.com))

**2) I registered last year, but can't remember my password?**

**3) Do I have to pay both the WEVA fee and the club fee?**

NO, your club fee includes the WEVA/USA fee.

**4) Do I have to pay the try-out fee and the registration fee?**

\*Boys trying out in the 15–18 age groups need to pay the try-out fee at the kick-off meeting or by the first try-out. The try-out fee is subtracted from the amount of registration should your son make one of the teams.

\*Boys in the 10-14 age group need to pay the registration at the kick-off meeting or by the first practice at the latest. (there is no try-out fee for these age groups)

**5) Do I have to pay online?**

NO, no payments are made online. All payments are collected through the club treasurer. (checks made payable to Rochester Pace Volleyball Club)

**6) When are registration payments due?**

Registration payments are due for the 12, 13, and 14 age groups at the first meeting or at the latest the first practice. Registration payment for all other age groups (15-18) is due at the first practice in December after the try-outs are over.

**7) I don't know which team my son should try-out for?**

There is an age definition sheet on the Pace website. A good rule is to think ahead to September 1<sup>st</sup>, whatever age your son is in the upcoming September is the age he should be playing. Often your son would like to play at a different age level, please sign him up for his actual level and then speak to one of the coaches at the tryout/practice.

**8) What paperwork do I need to have and when is it needed by?**

There are five pieces of paperwork **required for your son to participate in the first practice or try-out.**

From the WEVA website: the code of conduct (signed), WEVA/USA member application confirmation, medical release form (completely filled out and signed),

From the Pace site: the PACE club form (completely filled out and signed) and the Member Responsibility form (filled out and signed).

**9) What if my son doesn't make a team?**

Some teams will be having practice players. These are players that attend the practices, but don't participate in tournaments. Also, Victor Volleyball Club offers practices and a few tournaments for players in the area.

**10) I'm not sure that this club is right for my son.**
