



Welcome coaches, parents and players. Here are a few critical issues that we would like to clarify before the 2009 event begins. These will assist in making this event safe, enjoyable, and easy to manage. Representatives, please pass this information on to your coaches, parents and players.

Pre-tournament meeting- is at the Nazareth College Forum at the Shults Center in the middle of the campus. This is not mandatory and will have all updates, schedules, gifts, maps, coupons, event shirts and event procedures. All team packages that are not picked up will be handed out at your site. This will include the Bid Acceptance Form. Remember the form needs to be filled out and handed in at the beginning of the championship division play-offs signed by your coach or director.

Venues- All venues are within 15 minutes of each other except the Geneseo College site which is Geneseo thirty minutes from the host hotel (Rochester Plaza). All venues are located on the www.pacebootlegger.com website. All host sites are free except the Rochester Armory for the 18's and 15's. It is \$3.00 a day or \$5.00 for the weekend pass.

There are no coolers allowed in that venue.

12U site at Hot Shots Volleyball Club. They have an extensive menu and box lunches for the players. The order sheet will be in your packets. **No outside food or coolers at that location.**

14U site Geneseo College will have a concession stand and has food options that are close by. Coolers are allowed.

15U site Armory in the PM wave. **No outside food or coolers.** The restaurant will be available for customers.

16U sites at East High will have food and there is food close by (Coolers allowed) this is also the case for the Edison High School site and Monroe High School site.

17U site at Nazareth College has food and concessions. Coolers are allowed but only in certain areas. Teams are not allowed to roam around the hallways but are allowed in the gym and racquetball court area. School is in session. Monroe High School site has food close by.

18U site- Main Street Armory. **No outside food or coolers.** They will have a food service and a menu available.

Schedules- All schedules will be updated daily on the web-site. The schedule will not be out until Thursday. All teams will receive your first work assignment or start time by Wednesday. The flow chart and pools are up now on the web-site and are subject to change due to weather and other variables beyond the events control. Remember different venues have different start times. All venues begin at 8am except the 15's site (Armory) is a PM wave.

All coaches before they leave their site for the day need to sign their site scoreboard where the following day's schedule is located. Make sure you know your assignment before you leave.

Web-Site- The running schedule will be updated every three hours. There are multiple documents available for your help. The t-shirt order form is there and should already be sent in. If you are adding to your order please fill out a form and turn it into your Site director. There will only be team orders taken and prepared for pick-up at the Armory, Nazareth, and RIT sites.

Trainers- There are three trainers that will be available at any time during the event competition. They will be between the four main sites, Main Street Armory, Nazareth College, East High School and RIT.

Work Teams- All work teams are responsible for a parent/coach R2 with a team whistle, 2 lines people, flipper, scorekeeper and Libero tracker. **Bring your own whistle.**

Bid Acceptance- Forms are in your pre event information packet. Teams need to sign and turn in to site director whether you are accepting or declining. This is mandatory before the Championship Brackets begin. There are three bid allocations for the Can-Am with a minimum of 12 teams in each age division. Bids will drop to one for a minimum of 8 teams. All gold championships will play until all bids are accepted. Ex.(trickle down to 7th place).
